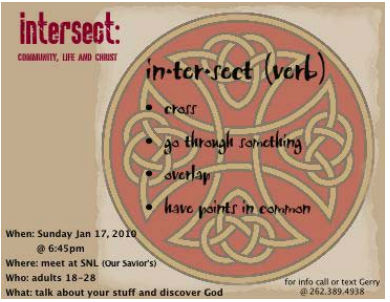

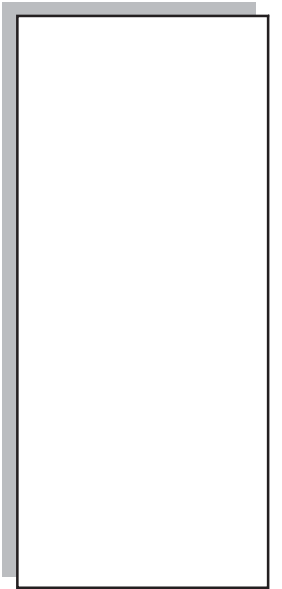

## View from the Hill by Pastor Gerry

A Concluding Word on The Full Armor

*Eph. 6:19, 20 ... "whenever I open my mouth, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should."*

The gospel is not hidden but it is mysterious. It's mysterious how the simple elements of what Paul describes as the full armor make us more like Christ. He reminds us that truth, righteousness, faith, the hope of salvation, a thorough knowledge of God's Word and continual communication with God through prayer give us insight for applying these qualities in every day life.

If you desire more insight into spiritual things, here's a couple tools. Read your Bible, a chapter a day. Answer the four "P's" for each chapter. What is the purpose of this passage, the problem mentioned in the chapter, the principle that needs to be followed, and the promise from God.

Talk to the Lord and listen to Him every moment. Set your phone alarm to go off a couple times a day and take a few precious moments to quiet yourself; remember the passage of scripture you read that morning; mention some immediate requests to the Lord; ask the Lord to use you and make you a blessing; and then go on with your day. This simple practice will deepen your knowledge and understanding of the mystery of the gospel. It will weave fearlessness into the fabric of your character because you will increase your respect for the Lord Jesus and diminish your fear of people. You will find opportunities to season your conversation with the wisdom of God's word. Your faith will be strengthened. God is faithful. Trust Him.

Eph. 6:24 Grace to all who love our Lord Jesus Christ with an undying love.

### Great Places for Summer Bible reading

**Genesis** - the beginning - creation, humanity, separation from God, the early promises of God, Noah, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob and Esau and much more

**Psalms** - a great place to read a chapter a day; the heart and soul of biblical writing; are you dealing with emotional upheaval? Read here

**Amos/Joel** - prophetic books that challenge the status quo. God's people grow complacent and need a jolt out of their spiritual rut.

**John** - No Christmas story here but it tells us much about the character of Christ and how He viewed himself. Jesus' parables, healings, teachings and compassion are the focus.

**The Acts of the Apostles** - the History book of the New Testament. Gives us a picture of the early church and the power of the Holy Spirit at work.

**Philippians** - Paul's most encouraging letter. He loved the church at Philippi and felt a great deal of companionship with them.
