View from the Hill by Pastor Gerry

Whether or not a person claims Christ, there is in every person yearning to find balance, purpose, contentment, satisfaction, hope, fulfillment, destiny and legacy. I'm convinced that God built that into us at creation. From a biblical perspective these qualities are found only when we experience restoration of relationship with our Creator through Jesus Christ. The latest in a long series of opinions about what life is really about includes a movie called "Eat, Pray, Love." The autobiographical account of one woman's search for happiness leads her to exit her dissatisfactory marriage and to go on a trip. According to Wikipedia she travels to Italy to "eat." Then it's on to India to "pray" and search within eastern religion for a sense of spirituality. Finally, it's on to Bali, Indonesia for new "love". What this movie reminds us is the spiritual hungering that lurks beneath the surface of life. Jesus spoke to this issue in the greatest sermon ever preached, "the sermon on the mount." He reminded each of us that the truest human experience is to join Christ in the kingdom of God. His kingdom is here and if we follow Christ we will know all the benefits that come from being in His kingdom.

Jesus outlines his vision for the kingdom. He reminds us that the truth of God, which is a characteristic of every member of the kingdom, is like a light (sun, city on a hill, lamp). Jesus also challenges every member to deep and complete character change. That visible obedience according to the law isn't the fulfillment of the law but rather having our thoughts captivated by the leadership and lordship of Christ (Matt 5:17-30; 2 Cor. 10:5).

Further, he says that love can't be wasted. Jesus turns the entire world on its head when he challenges citizens of the kingdom of God to love their enemies and to go the extra mile with those who seek to take advantage of them. That's merely the truth Jesus has laid out through Matthew chapter 5. I love learning about what it means to be part of Christ's kingdom and to see Jesus' kingdom unfolding within our fellowship, community and world.

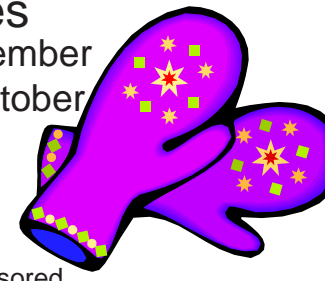
