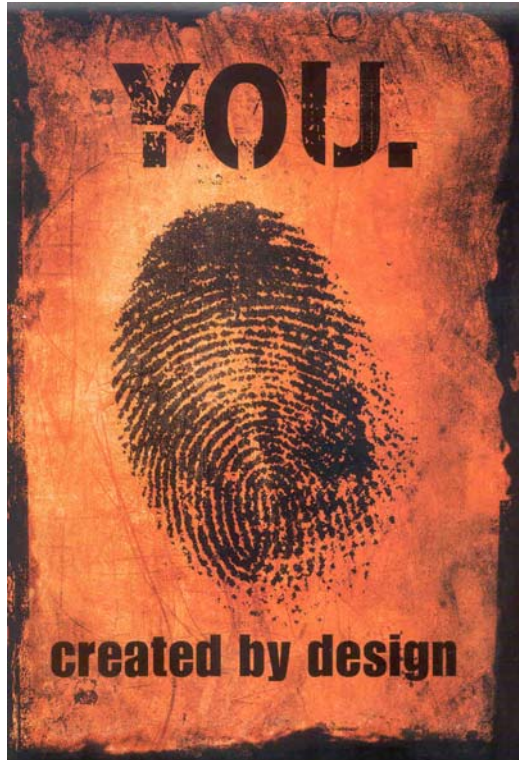

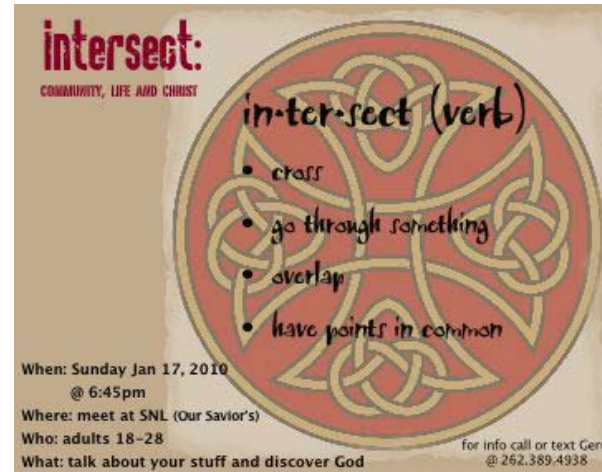

View from the Hill by Pastor Gerry

PURPOSE: To BE and to DEVELOP Wholehearted followers of Jesus Christ.

We live in a day when the generic is more preferred than the specific. We prefer generic medicines over name branded ones. We're happy with Great Value Frosted Flakes and don't need Tony the Tiger's brand.

We are more comfortable talking about God than we are Jesus or the Holy Spirit. God is the safe term. Less specific. It's transferrable in conversations. If someone talks about God everyone can apply their own definition to who God is. The drive in society is to broaden, blur, and fog up the specifics so as to include as many as possible.

The Bible has always been specific. God revealed exactly who He is to Moses at the burning bush, "Tell them I AM sent you." To reveal one's name, in the Semitic world is to give access to yourself. It's almost like giving someone the pass code to your garage door opener.

When Jesus appeared on earth a specific revelation occurred. The very likeness of God in human form. Not a generic but a concrete presence. His generation crucified Him for 'blasphemy.' Specifically, Jesus' blasphemy was claiming to be God. The controversy hasn't ceased since then.

We are unashamed in calling people to be wholehearted followers of Jesus Christ. The Bible outlines a very specific path to eternal life...through Him. "I am the way and the truth and the life. No-one comes to the Father except through me," Jesus said.

Exciting days are happening at Our Savior's. We have seen people, in very recent days, come to know Jesus. I am believing the Lord for 12 new converts over the next year. People who wholeheartedly give themselves to Christ! One a month. It could be a child from our AWANA or children's church program or a student from CrossRoad Ministries or an adult who is introduced to a relationship with the Word of God, Jesus Christ.

On another matter, we've been blessed with the donation of a piece of property. We have a facilities task force looking at next phase building options and doing an assessment of our ministry needs. This property can provide either cash flow or equity toward our next phase building project. Praise the Lord for His provision! Please pray for the overseers of this church fellowship as they consider future direction for our church community.

Let's increase our spiritual intensity and press towards the goals that God has for us. We use five phrases to describe our mission, EVANGELIZE our world, EXALT the Lord, EQUIP the believer, EXHORT the disciple, and EXTEND the kingdom. Let's trust the Lord to grow the kingdom through the ministries of Our Savior's and the Spirit-filled witness of our people.
